To assist members individuals, the Foundation Board of Directors may budget funds to provide tuition assistance to support training and education. Individuals may apply for the Foundation's Adult Scholarship Program by completing the application.

Guidelines for Consideration:

- Complete the application fully prior to submitting to the CCFB Foundation for Board consideration.
- Submission requests should be typed using the approved CCFB application and returned to ccfb@cookcfb.org.
- Applicants must be a Cook County Farm Bureau member paid in good standing age 22 or older.
- The personal recommendation form can be used to strengthen your scholarship request

Adult Scholarship Opportunities:

- Members may be eligible for a tuition scholarship for the ALOT or IALP training
- Members may be eligible for tuition reimbursement of partial registration fees following successful completion of U of I Extension Master Gardner Training-South Cook Unit or Master Urban Farmer Training Program (MUFTP)
- Members may be eligible for tuition reimbursement of partial or full registration fees following attendance at education, training, education or conference
